The interaction was further enriched by a dedicated question-and-answer round, which allowed participants to delve deeper into the entrepreneurial journey and the scientific principles behind the technology. The engaging discussion underscored the critical link between scientific research and its application in creating viable, impactful solutions in the healthcare market. The event concluded with the speaker being honored with a certificate of appreciation, recognizing his valuable contribution to fostering a culture of innovation within the institution





# Field Visit at Trisamya Center for Photomedicine





A field visit was conducted at TRISAMYA, a photomedicine center in Kharghar, specializing in Photobiomodulation (PBM) therapy. The center employs a non-invasive, LED-based technology that uses specific visible light frequencies to stimulate cellular activity. This therapy, also referred to as Photo-Immunomodulation (PIM), is designed to modulate the immune system, promote tissue repair, and reduce inflammation. They have a team of Dermatologists, Physiotherapists, and Cosmetologists in-house.

During the visit, faculty members posed several key queries concerning the practical and ethical aspects of establishing a medical device-based practice in their various fields. A significant portion of the conversation was dedicated to the Ethics Committee (EC) for any research or clinical investigations. The faculty also inquired about the specific inclusion and exclusion criteria for patients, which are crucial for ensuring patient safety and the integrity of treatment outcomes. This included discussions on conditions like photosensitive epilepsy, pregnancy, or the presence of tumours, which are often considered contraindications for PBM therapy.

# Meetings with NGO's




Meetings with NGOs were planned where Dr.
