Thank you for the opportunity to serve, and I look forward to witnessing the continued growth and success of our college.



All the females students of the high school were made to sit in one hall . Questions were asked to the students to assist their knowledge about menstruation and it's hygiene 60% of the female students were in pre menstrual period. Students were encouraged to share their own experience to the younger students , this made them more comfortable and receptive about the topic .Later presentation for menstrual hygiene followed by demonstration of products was done. Importance of Nutrition and physical exerciseduring menstruation was being highlighted to them
