

GUIDELINES

- 1. Bring in your pre-loved gently used books that you want to share with your fellow members and submit to the organizing committee on the informed date.
- 2.All fictional, non-fictional, drama, poetry genres are accepted. Although kindly refrain from getting books that touch upon controversy, politics, religion, obscenity and other sensitive topics.
- 3. Not able to get you own books? Still participate ! We have arranged for books from the library.
- 4. All books will be numbered and labelled upon receipt.
- 5. Make sure that you register your names and other details to the

volunteer upon submitting the books.

- 6. The book swap will take place on the scheduled date of the event wherein you will be distributed books on a randomization basis.
- 7.A maximum of 4 (four) books will be issued to a student for roughly 20 days from the date of issue.
- 8. Binding of the books should be intact both on the inside and outside of the book upon return.
- 9. No writing, highlighting or underlining on the text pages.
- 10. Users should not deface, cut, mutilate or damage the books in any form. If found guilty, user will be charged double the cost of that particular material.
- 11. Eatables/personal books or journals will not be allowed in the auditorium during the event.
- 12. At the end of the reading period, members are expected to *return the books with a short book review or their personal highlights* about the book.
