practitioners play in the society.






NATIONAL DENTIST DAY EVENTS

1st prize - Yashvi Hodar 2nd prize - Rhea D'Cunha 3rd prize - Apeksha Sanghvi





March 8th, 2022.

On the occasion of International women's day, the Department of Periodontics had arranged a state level CDE programme on the topic "Regeneration in Dentistry". The programme was in collaboration with The Scientific Society MGMDCH and Geistlich biomaterials.



The lecture covered topics such as ridge preservation, sinus grafting, horizontal augmentation and attached gingiva buildup and overall importance and possibility for regeneration and not just tissue repair.





The guest speaker for the programme was Dr
Ashwini Bhalerao who was named the Oral
surgeon of the year in 2013 by the Famdent
Excellence in Dentistry Awards, Pan-India.
She was instrumental in initiating the use of
Piezo Surgical Unit in implant-related
surgeries such as sinus lift, ridge-split and
bone augmentation.





The programme also included a demonstration of sinus floor elevation and socket preservation using new innovative and progressive products from Geistlich biomaterials.

Apart from the educational lecture, the mere presence and the words of Dr Ashwini Bhalerao ma'am, proved to be motivational for the students to achieve more than what the society binds you to, regardless of your gender. 


MEGA FOLLOW UP CAMP FOR CLEFT AND CRANIOFACIAL PATIENTS

All the participants displayed vigour putting maximum efforts. Multiple teams from all over Maharashtra had participated for the event.










STATE LEVEL DENTAL STUDENT CONFERENCE - FATHOM 1.0




